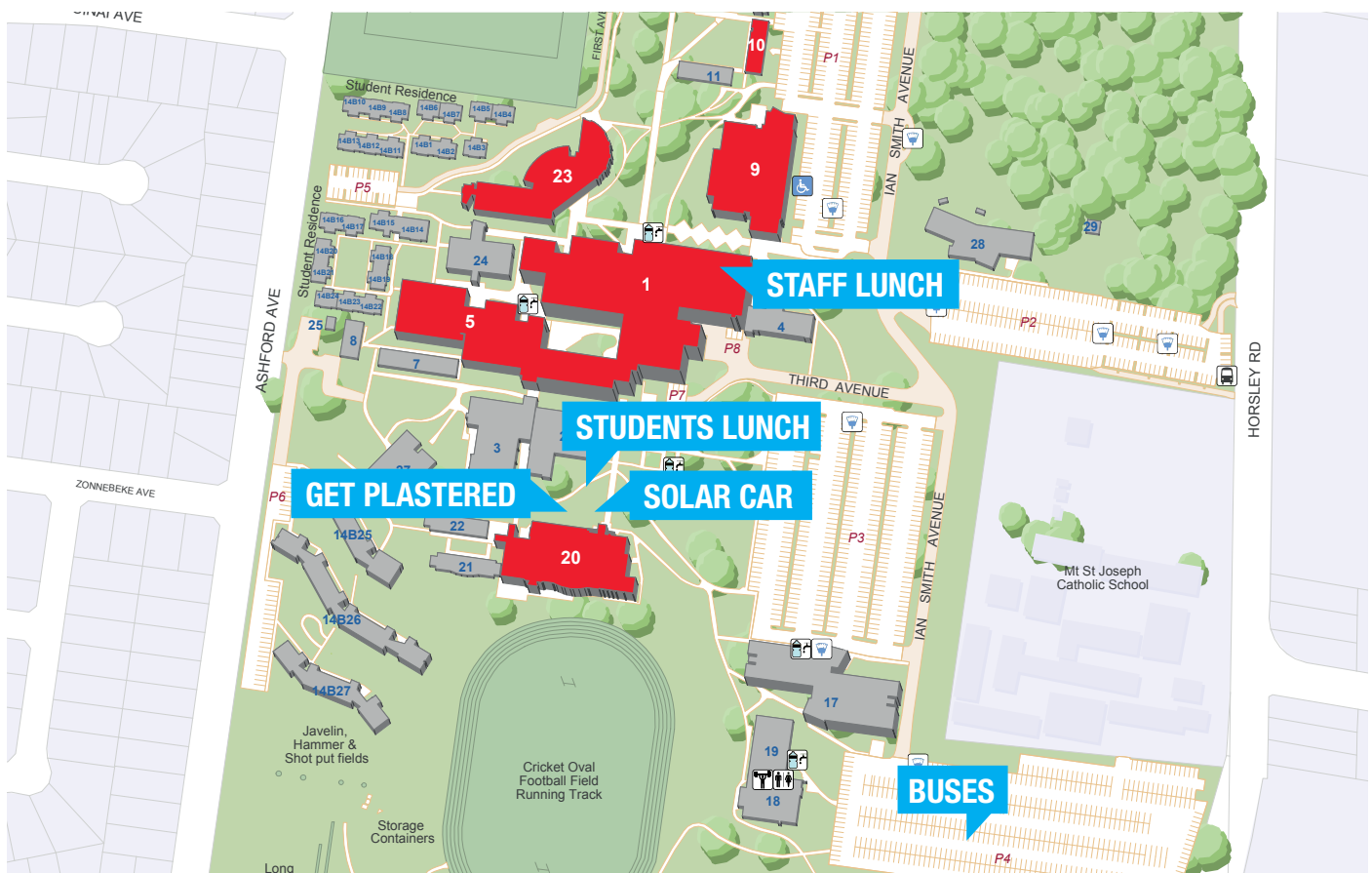
WELCOME TO UWS DAY!
